## **Faculty Position, Yonsei University**

Responsibilities will include teaching one undergraduate and one graduate course per semester (in English), supervising graduate student research, developing and directing funded research projects, publishing research results in leading journals and conferences and participating in department, college, university, professional and public service. Applicants must have a PhD in Computer Science or in a closely related field. Preference will be given to candidates with more than one year of academic work experience after PhD.

Yonsei University is a research university located in Seoul, South Korea. Established in 1885, it has a longstanding tradition as Korea's first private university. Today, Yonsei University is widely regarded as one of the top five universities in South Korea. The Department of Computer Science and Engineering at Yonsei University currently consists of 17 tenure-track faculty and offers BS, MS and PhD programs to a student body of 200 graduate and 400 undergraduate students. The department encompasses a wide range of research areas including bioinformatics, database technologies, data mining, computer graphics, computer vision, AI, HCI, networking and communications, parallel computing, computer architectures, embedded systems, and theoretical computer science.

- A. Completed application form.
- B. Statement of religious background.
- C. Copies of diplomas and official transcripts (with GPAs) of undergraduate and graduate programs (for each institution attended).
- D. List of research activities: papers (including title, authors, date of publication, abstract and name of journal/conference). Research activities must be listed in a prescribed form.
- E. Copies of all research work for the past 4 years, and a copy of the doctoral dissertation.
- F. For applicants with professional experience, a portfolio including detailed descriptions of professional experiences, achievements and qualifications.
- G. At least two letters of reference.

Results of the hiring search for new faculty members will be posted on the university website in December 2009. In principle, application materials will not be returned. Applications are not complete until all required documents have been received. The appointment will commence in March 2010.
