



Postdoctoral Associate with option on a career track (assistant professor, associate professor -not limited-, habilitation)

The Institute of Computer Graphics at the Faculty of Technology and Natural Science at the Johannes Kepler University Linz (www.jku.at/cg, http://www.jku.at/content) is seeking a postdoctoral associate according to the wage agreement of university employees and UG for full time employment.

The position is initially limited to 6 years, but offers the option for an unlimited employment in the course of a qualification agreement. This agreement can be made within the first two years and provides the option on a career track with assistant professor and unlimited associate professor positions. In the course of this career track, a habilitation degree (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Habilitation) in computer science is intended.

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. or Dr. degree in computer science or related fields, such as mathematics or media-informatics, and should have profound knowledge and experience in computer graphics/visualization and/or computer vision – with an adequate record of international publications. Independent scientific work as well as the establishment and lead of an own research group is expected.

Additional duties include the support of the acquisition of third-party funds and the collaboration in teaching. Candidates must be fluent in English (speaking and writing).
